Re: 200 Block of Ascot Place NE Request for RPP


Dear DDOT:

At today's public meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 5E, the issue of whether or not to support the request for Residential Permit Parking (RPP) for the 200 Block of Ascot Place NE by its residents was on the agenda and the following facts were determined:

1. The residents of the 200 Block of Ascot Place NE have completed two separate petitions to request Residential Permit Parking.
2. A number of residents of SMD 5E10 residing on the 200 Block of Ascot Place NE have complained of issues parking on their own block due to number of non-residents parking on the block. The residents are not able to park on adjacent blocks because those blocks have RPP and since their block does not they are not able to get RPP allowing them to park for more than 2 hours.
3. The residents of the 200 Block of Ascot Place NE stated that their parking issues are further compounded during the months of street cleaning since they cannot park on neighboring blocks with RPP and can only park on one side of their block.
4. The residents of the 200 Block of Ascot Place NE ask that their block have RPP to be consistent with other blocks in their neighborhood and to reduce out of state vehicles parking and using the block for short and long term parking.

Based on these findings, ANC5E, on June 16, 2015, with 9 of 10 elected Commissioners present, 6 representing a quorum, voted 8 in favor, 0 opposed, with 1 abstentions, to support the request for RPP for the 200 Block of Ascot Place NE by its residents.
